

Double Occupancy - \$200 per person Single Occupancy - \$275 per person (does not guarantee private bath)


There are just a few rooms which have bathrooms included. Others rooms will require 4-6 persons to share hall bathrooms.

### **Required Minimum Distribution (RMD)**

If you are over 70 1/2 and have an investment plan, you are required to withdraw a percentage, determined by the IRS, every year by December 31st. If you take this as income it is a taxable event to you.




