The new program called "Bags for Beds" will meet on Thursday, June 6 then will be taking a break for summer.




#### From the Church Mouse.....


Our little mouse family sure enjoyed those yummy ribs the other day. Smelled them cooking outside and came in to check them out. Good food and good music a great day for a mouse
