Where do I place my fears? How can I improve my relationships? How can I improve my marriage? What church should I attend?

What school should I send my children to? How do I pay for college? I am lonely, *does God care? (*YES)

I guess you can finish the list and most likely add many things to it.

Here it is — COMMIT your CAUSE to the Lord and He will show you the right way. In a world offering so many confusing directions that often lead nowhere, this is a TREASURE TRUTH to hold onto. It is so liberating that we can COMMIT all of our CAUSES to God. He will guide and lead you in the path of truth and success.





includes someone you know and love. With humor and spiritual reminders of God's love, he suggests many practical things families can do to make the experience safer, kinder and more endurable for everyone involved.




