### The Exclusivity of the Gospel!

#### **Jesus the Good Shepherd**

Then Jesus said to them again, "Truly, truly I say to you, I am the door of the sheep. All who came before Me are thieves and robbers, but the sheep did not listen to them. I am the door. If anyone enters through Me, he will be saved and will go in and out and find pasture. The thief does not come, except to steal and kill and destroy. I came that they may have life, and that they may have it more abundantly.

#### **Dear Church Family,**

Hope you are well! I would like to start out with a question. "How many ways are there to God-Do all ways lead to Him?" According to this scripture from the Gospel of John, chapter 10, there is only one way, the right way to God. This way is found in JESUS. He Himself said it, not a Theologian. See verse 9 again, "I (Jesus) am the gate; whoever enters through Me will be saved". This is not the only scripture passage, there are more. A hot topic in our world... For it seems to reflect intolerance and seems to be prideful to have such exclusive claims. Yet, Jesus paid an incredible price for it. He gave His life and with His death

more loving and merciful-consequently reaching out to those around us and sharing Christ.

I was surprised to read in a book written by a Pastor/ Evangelist, who died in 1966, about the opposition in his time and society to Christ's exclusive claims. As a Pastor, I have heard many interesting arguments about how Jesus is only one of the many ways to God and heard about peoples' doubts.

#### Such as:

- A. How can God allow this to happen?
- B. Cain and Abel were brothers. Cain killed Abelso where did he get his wife from?
- C. One of the most pressing ones for me as Pastor is:
  You always talk about Jesus, is this not a little
  fanatical? It is not so important what way we go
  and what religion we have; just as long as we
  believe.

Why would God have sacrificed His Son, Jesus, if it did not matter in the end?

This Pastor/Evangelist I mentioned earlier, who witnessed in the 1960's about the Bibles and Jesus' exclusive claims, shares an example. A story that made me laugh, but it did drive the point home to me. \* "One time I was in Berlin at the airport-Tempelhof Feld Airport. Before we could get into the plane, we had to go through a passport control. In front of me stood a tall guy-one of those two-story guys. He had a big travel blanket under his arm. He quickly

handed his passport to the Officer. The Officer said," Wait a minute, your passport expired." The gentleman answered, "Don't be so picky, the main thing is I have a passport!" "No". The officer replied, "The main thing is you have a passport that is not expired." (\*Quote from "Jesus Unser Schicksal" –By: Wilhelm Busch- "Jesus Our Destiny" Translation mine).

Jesus, by no accident made this exclusive claim for He has for you and me what it takes to live this life and eventually enter eternity. Jesus is the Way, the Truth, and the Life. God means what He says. We as Christians today deal with the same issues maybe a little more intense then the Pastor in the 60's. We must be merciful and loving to others and yet remain grounded and steadfast in the claims that Christ made.
