Just the other day I was reminded of an experience that I had while I was on a Medical Mission trip to Eastern Europe in 2002. It was our last day before returning to the States. We had some meetings in the morning in Budapest and in the afternoon, we had time for sightseeing in the city before getting ready for our trip back. I did some last-minute shopping and just walked through the city. Walked by several museums, walked next to the Danube River and meandered through the shopping district right in downtown. Right next to the entrance of the subway station I noticed a lady sitting on the ground with a little sign in front of her. She was asking for support, for money. I felt my conscience crying out-"Help her, give her some money."

It was not a hard decision for I had just spent money on some delicious Hungarian pastry so I put some money in her little paper box and went my merry way. Later that afternoon I walked by the same spot again and felt the urge to give her more money. I did, and just like before again I noticed that she was stooped down so far with a scarf over her head that you could not see her face. My heart really went out to her. After leaving money in her paper box I continued my stroll. Having walked just a short distance I felt God calling me to go back and speak with this lady. I really didn't want to do that. She was sitting at a very public place. Many people passing by her spot. What are people going to think? Well, I knew better, when God asks do not argue! So, I turned around and went back to this lady, stooped down right next to where she was sitting. We started to talk. She showed me a photo of her husband's funeral. We did have some communication problems for she spoke a different language. All I could do was to point to the sky and say in Hungarian, "Jesus, Jesus, call on Jesus"- That was international sign language we can understand. She smiled and we were able to communicate despite the language barrier.

I remember going back to our lodging place very much at peace with the wonderful knowledge that God guides our lives with a very specific purpose. It is up to us is we let Him use us for the building up of people's lives and the furthering of His Kingdom on this earth. Watch out for the presence of God in your life today! Do not forget to show hospitality to strangers, for by so doing some people have shown hospitality to angels without knowing it. (Hebrews 13:2)

We just started a new Mission outreach to Homeless families. Right here at the NPCUCC. Initiated by Mrs. Mina Sundeen.






New to the shelf is "That Good Night: Life and Medicine in the Eleventh Hour" by Sunita Puri. Does modern medicine reckon with the friction that exists between





Lots of those snowy birds have been saying good bye every week. We are sad to see them go, but know they will be back again when things get too cold


