

I came across this Hymn. Here I share the words with you.

- "O Jesus, Thou Art Standing"
- 1. O Jesus, thou art standing outside the fast-closed door, in lowly patience waiting to pass the threshold o'er: shame on us, Christian brothers, His name and sign who bear, O shame, thrice shame upon us, to keep him standing there!
- 2. O Jesus, thou art knocking; and lo, that hand is scarred, and thorns thy brow encircle,

O love that passeth knowledge,
so patiently to wait!
O sin that hath no equal,
so fast to bar the gate!

3 O Jesus, thou art pleading in accents meek and low, "I died for you, my children, and will ye treat me so?" O Lord, with shame and sorrow we open now the door; dear Savior, enter, enter, and leave us nevermore.

Is your life busy, one scheduled event after the other? Your appointment calendar filled to the limit? Yes, life can be so fast-paced and so hectic at times. 





On Tuesday, October 15th the Safety Team met. We continue to work on the plan for evacuation in case of an emergency such as fire, etc.


There are some changes on Sunday mornings that may or may not effect you. Please read carefully so you are aware of these changes.

Beginning on Sunday, October 20th our Safety Team members began their duties. Members of the Safety Team are located at the front entrance to monitor the parking lot and another is located at the office door. The only doors that will be unlocked on Sunday morning are the front sanctuary doors. They will be unlocked at 9:00 a.m. and then locked once the service begins. We will no longer be unlocking the office door, kitchen door or the door between the buildings.

The Safety Team Member at the office door will be there between 9:00 and 9:45 a.m. to let you in. For those attending Adult Sunday school, you may enter Decker Hall when Pastor Attila arrives. Following your class you should enter through the main doors of the sanctuary. We appreciate your cooperation with these changes.


