

October Navigator

Dear Church Family,

We hope you and your family are doing well. Every year around this time the countdown begins! Counting the days till Reformation Sunday! It has become a tradition for our church family to look back at the people and events, the movers and shakers of the Protestant Reformation. This year again we will enter the Great Hall of Fame of the heroes of the faith and study their impact on the church and society. Please join us as we look back in time and history to give thanks for the courage of our reforming ancestors.

Here are some of the pillar teachings for the Protestant Reformation! Solus Christus: Christ Alone! Describes a basic and fundamental truth of Protestant Theology. It means what the Bible testifies to when it describes Jesus as The Way, The Truth and The Life! Through whom alone we have salvation and access to the father. Not through other mediators. Which was a huge part of the Theological debate in the days of Luther and other Reformers. The next is Sola Fide: Through Faith Alone! This is of foremost importance in the mind of protestant Christendom. It expresses simply the thought that as humans we don't earn God's love and recognition through works but alone through faith. A relationship with God becomes experiential and real. Like the Bible says: "And it is impossible to please God without faith!" (Hebrews 11:6)

Another one the list is Sola Gratia: Through Grace Alone! The idea here is that humans cannot gain the Grace and favor of God via their actions but only through God's action. Described for us in Romans 3:21-28 "And are justified freely by his grace through the redemption that came by Christ Jesus." (Romans 3:24)

Finally, Sola Scriptura: Through the Scriptures Alone! The reformers declared that the scriptures are sufficient in delivering the salvation plan of God to humankind and that no addition was needed. It was sufficient in those days and it is sufficient today. This was to get away from all the heresies that were running rampant in the church in those days!

Now maybe church history is not your cup of tea, the reason why we look back is to see how God sends us out today in our times and what we can learn from the past to apply in our setting today. Dietrich Bonhoeffer put it like this: "The inquiry about historical heritage is not, therefore the timeless question of the eternally valid values of the past. Rather, it is that human beings, placed in history must give an accounting to themselves about the present time as it has been taken on by God in Christ." (From ethics 103-104)

Please keep the many ministries of our church in prayer! Thank you for all that you are doing! We love and appreciate you. We could not do ministry without your help.







They reviewed information received from the North Port Fire Department regarding fire safety and fire drills. You will be hearing more about that in the future.


Also:



Please come on October 6th prepared to make your generous donation.

Required Minimum Distribution (RMD)

If you are over 70 1/2 and have an investment plan, you are required to withdraw a percentage, determined by the IRS, every year by December 31st. If you take this as income it is a taxable event to you.

A great way to avoid taxes, and to fulfill your church pledge, is to donate this, or a portion of it, to North Port Community United Church of Christ. This can be simply done by contacting your broker.
