Then David continues... all this helps me to depend on the LORD-really depend on Him.

This story brought tears to my eyes when I heard it. At the same time it blessed me to know that our GOD in Jesus Christ is our ROCK we can and need to stand on. The LORD our Savior knows where we are in life and He is taking care of us. We trust Him one circumstance and situation at a time. Let's do that together!







Six persons attended the August 6th Safety Workshop in Englewood and received more valuable information that is needed to continue with the formation of our North Port Community UCC Safety Team.


A formal Safety Team will be proposed to the Trustees and then to Council for approval on September 10th.

It's Hurricane Season, so REMEMBER: Our church policy for closing the church in the event of a storm is—



Anytime hurricane conditions are <u>predicted</u> for a Sunday morning, including the possibility of winds high enough to prevent emergency workers from being on the roads, services will be canceled. So.... If on Saturday night, hurricane conditions are being predicted for North Port, you may know that Sunday services are canceled—even if conditions are improved on Sunday morning.

Required Minimum Distribution (RMD)

If you are over 70 1/2 and have an investment plan, you are required to withdraw a percentage, determined by the IRS, every year by December 31st. If you take this as income it is a taxable event to you.

A great way to avoid taxes, and to fulfill your church pledge, is to donate this, or a portion of it, to North Port Community United Church of Christ. This can be simply done by contacting your broker.
